I am writing to inquiry about missing documentation from my submission of appeal for the High Rock Herd Management, EA# CA-370-06-16, IBLA #2006-292.

I have just received the "appeal package" with all the current documentation for proceeding, including the Surprise Field Offices responses, submissions and evidence.

My appeal was included as Exhibit #3 but was missing the supplementation I had supplied in the back. These documents were not supplied separately. They were uniformly stapled with the entire presentation. I had also included them in the CD copy requested by the court for its convenience.

These documents were submitted as part of my supporting evidence for my allegations of "failure to respond to the public in any significant manner" by including the questions I had asked regarding the proposal.

While documentation was provided for the Surprise Field Offices response to the public questions and comments, the exclusion of my questions prevents the reader for verifying if the Surprise Field Office did indeed respond and address the questions and concerns of the public.

I believe they are a significant and relevant inclusion into the evaluation of this case. While perhaps not all comments or statements were within the scope of the proposal, some of them are extremely relevant and pertinent and deserved attention.

Therefore, I am writing the court to ask for a response as to why these documents were removed and what reasoning there was for their removal.

If I submitted them in an inappropriate format and need to re-submit them under an appendix or such, please let me know the proper procedure for inclusion.
