Your email dated December 20, 2007, to Allen Biaggi, Director of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, and Cathy Barcomb, Administrator of the Commission for the Preservation of Wild Horses, was forwarded to me for response. In the email, you requested "to be notified of EVERY PUBLIC action that you as the Administrator. . . is involved with, every action the Commission itself is publicly involved with, whether individually or collectively, as well as the . . . Director or any representative . . . of the Department of [Conservation and] Natural Resources."

Please be informed that Mr. Biaggi and Ms. Barcomb are not considered a "public body" under NRS 241.015(3). Thus, we cannot accommodate your request to be notified of their activities. Furthermore, the Commission for the Preservation of Wild Horses, although a "public body" under NRS 241.015(3), needs only to notify you of its public meetings where a quorum is present. See NRS 241.020.
