One Horse or Burro Per Every 5,233.4515 acres

The absolute maximum forage a wild horse has been known to utilize is 25 acres per month.

This equates to a maximum of 300 acres of forage required per horse, per year.

The absolute maximum forage a wild burro has been known to utilized is 12.5 acres per month.

This equates to a maximum of 150 acres of forage required per burro, per year.
