Actions:

Designating or changing allotment boundaries, increasing or decreasing permitted use, modifications of terms and conditions of grazing permits, development or revision of Allotment Management Plans, planning range developments or range improvements (i.e. fencing), issuance or renewal of grazing permits, reports which evaluate monitoring data (i.e., allotment evaluations), issuance of non-renewable grazing permits (i.e., Temporary Non-Renewable), closure of

allotments due to drought, fire, flood, insect infestation, or when use would pose significant resource damage, adjustments to wild horse appropriate management levels, all management actions including wild horse and burro removals, wild horse and burro management plans, wildlife proposals including species introductions, habitat improvements or enhancements, biological opinions, changes to HMA boundaries or designations, Resource Management Plans, designated Wilderness Areas or Wilderness Study Areas, and the Black Rock Range National Conservation Areas.

Other proposals that affect the listed HA, HMAs and allotments including: OHV Management Plans, Mining, Geothermal, Water Rights & Transfers, new public lands designations and proposals and any other management plan, proposal or action that would affect the areas listed of interest that are currently unforeseen.
